In 2015, we developed a mobile dental clinic program to help control the costs of dental care, taking the services directly to seniors. Our vision is to serve the Intermountain West. We currently assist seniors who reside in seven northern Utah Counties through various grant-funding resources. As a new Medicaid provider, we are looking forward to collaborating with the University of Utah as an affiliate to bring Medicaid services to seniors in care facilities and senior apartments in January 2020.

Our state-of-the-art mobile dental practice is searching for a skilled and experienced Dentist with excellent communication skills and compassionate concerns for low-income seniors to join our professional team. Dentist responsibilities

- Diagnose and provide appropriate dental treatment to patients, including regular cleanings, fillings, extractions, semi-permanent crowns, full and partial dentures

- Communicate with dental staff on our team regarding patient treatment plans
- Prescribe medications as necessary
- Carefully document diagnoses and treatments
- Guide the work of professional, technical and administrative staff and AmeriCorps members
