What difference does your donation make in the lives of seniors? Here is one couple's story: Nada and Marko came to Utah about ten years ago from the former Yugoslavia due to religious persecution. Not having any children of their own, they loved the time spent babysitting and playing with the children in their old neighborhood.

Due to poor vision, Nada and Marko were unable to find a way to be involved with children here. Upon moving into a senior apartment in Salt Lake City, they were referred to the Senior Charity Care Foundation (SCCF) for assistance. They obtained their prescriptions and we helped them get new glasses.

With his new glasses not only came a better ability to see -- Marko was accepted as a foster grandparent at an nearby elementary school. Once Nada's prescription is changed to progressive lenses (no-lined bifocals) so that she can read, she plans to join him.
